- Have a valid Wisconsin driver's license
- Attend the crowing ceremony the second Saturday in June at the Dane County Breakfast on the Farm
- Be available to commit to attending at least 15-20 promotional events throughout Dane County and beyond between April 2019-March 2020
- Be available during the entire week of the Dane County Fair
- Be able to attend the Wisconsin Association of Fairs Convention and participate in the Wisconsin Fairest of the Fairs competition in early January of 2020
