Live interactive video judging (by Face-Time, Skype, etc.) is an option for youth exhibitors not able to be present at the Fair during Individual Conference Judging, Wednesday, July 17, 2019. Project must be physically presented at Fair with a representative for the youth providing their own electronic equipment (i.e. iPad/tablet with an 8-inch or larger screen) for the youth to speak live through interactive video with the judge. Specific Departments/Classes, listed below, will be allowed for live video conferencing. Request to live video judge the project must be made by entry deadline on this request form. Youth participating in electronic presentation as well as their onsite representative must be prepared to wait in line to present their project(s), as do all youth exhibitors for individual conference. The youth's project must be presented directly and in person to the judge. The onsite representative must establish internet connection and administer their electronic device. All discussion regarding the project must be communicated only by the youth to/with the Judge. Technical difficulty experienced with an exhibitor's electronic device, resulting in the inability for the judge to adequately evaluate his/her project will result in rule 11.a.1. "... will result in lower placing by one color and no premium will be paid for this exhibit; Exhibit will be ineligible for special awards." Staff and Department chair will be the final decision maker to confirm or deny this live video conference judging request.

The youngest age Class/Lots and projects that require on-site preparation or assembly/demonstration will not be eligible for video conference judging.
