Release of Exhibits for Sunday, July 21

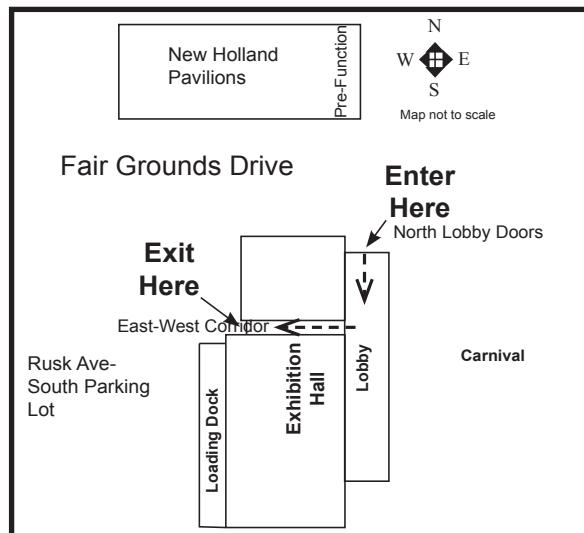
Exhibits will be released starting at 7:30 p.m. on Sunday. Exhibits removed before 7:30 p.m. on Sunday will result in all premiums being forfeited and the exhibitor being barred from participating for one year. **No exceptions.**

Exhibition Hall – Project Release

6:30 p.m. Doors Closed
7:30 p.m. Doors Open for Project Pick-up

- Entries must be picked-up between 7:30 - 8:30 p.m.
- In an effort to ease congestion during release in the Exhibition Hall, exhibitors must enter through the North Lobby doors and exit by way of the East-West Corridor (see map).
- Claim checks **must** be used to pick-up projects. **If claim checks have been lost, the exhibitor will need to go to the designated project area with proper photo ID.**
- If you are not able to pick-up projects during this time, please arrange for someone that can and remember to pass along your claim checks.
- Fair assumes no responsibility for any exhibits remaining after 8:30 p.m.

NOTE: Admission is charged on Sunday. However, between the hours of 7-8 p.m., one parent/guardian and one youth exhibitor will be allowed to show the exhibitor's claim ticket at any gate and receive free admission. **This time frame will be strictly enforced.** Proceed to the North entrance of the Exhibition Hall between 7:30 and 8:30 p.m. for project pick-up. When picking up exhibits from the Exhibition Hall, it is recommended you park in the Rusk Avenue entrance parking lot.



Pavilion 1 Pre-function - Project Release:

Animal & Vet Science Exhibits, Plant & Soil Science, Natural Science

- 6:30 p.m. Pre-function doors will close for preparation of project release.
7:30 p.m. To keep an orderly fashion for project release in the pre-function area, exhibitors must enter through the lobby doors and exit at the most southern door into the Pavilion.

Pavilions – Animal Release

- 6:30 p.m. Stall decorations may be taken down
7:30 p.m. Trucks & Trailers are allowed in the North Parking lot. Trailers will queue in the North Parking lot. Walking animals out to trailers on Willow Island or Olin Avenue Access road is not allowed.
