Performance Participation Process

Youth performers are encouraged to submit applications to perform at the Dane County Fair, July 18-21, 2019. **Individual or group performances are welcome.**

Application Process:

- Complete the “Youth & Community Stage Performance Sign-up Form” *and submit by mail or email by July 1.* Late applications may not be accepted or will be put on a wait list.
- Selection is on a first come–first-serve basis. The contact person listed on the application will be notified by email of acceptance and performance schedule in early July or as the application is received. Final performance materials will also be included in this notification.

Participant Fees:

All performers will receive a complimentary day pass to the Dane County Fair that will be mailed or delivered to participants prior to the Fair. Additional contacts, chaperones and family members who plan to attend the 2019 Dane County Fair will need to purchase admission tickets. These can be purchased on-site at the gate. Pricing is listed below:

- General Admission (12 years and older) - \$8 each
- Children ages 6-11 - \$3 each
- Children ages 5 and under - Free

Performance General Information

1. Each performance will perform on the Main Stage under the Entertainment Tent.
2. Performances will be assigned either a **10, 20, or 30-minute stage time** (includes setup/takedown).
3. Stage dimensions: 24’ wide by 20’ deep, raised about 16” above floor level. One set of stairs are located at the side of the stage.
4. Props and belongings can be stored near the stage; however, there is no locked storage area. Space is limited, so please keep props to a minimum as all participants share the area. Changing areas available near the tent by request.
5. Sound for all performances will be managed by Intellasound. The Youth & Community Stage will have microphones, speakers, sound system, etc. and controlled by Intellasound. The sound system is equipped to play CDs and iPods which will be amplified through speakers. If you using an iPod, make sure it is fully charged and bring a back-up CD if possible.

Performers are not allowed to bring or use their own sound equipment. This includes, but is not limited to: wireless and choral microphones, speakers, lighting, etc. Additionally, only staff is allowed behind the sound table to control any sound component.

SUGGESTION: We do our best to project the performers’ voices but there will always be unavoidable noise at the Dane County Fair regardless of what sound equipment is used. We have a mobile audience and the area is noisy, so the use of microphones is necessary for performances to be heard. Encourage performers to practice with the Fair stage set-up in mind.

6. A music stand, extension cord, table and chairs can be available **IF** requested at time when application is submitted (by July 1).
