



Clothing Revue Moves to the Fair: Wednesday, July 15

In response to the current Covid-19 situation and limitations on social gathering in place through June, the Clothing, Knitting & Crocheting Revue is moving to Wednesday, July 15 from 3 p.m. – 6:30 p.m. to coincide with project entry day for the Dane County Fair.

Exhibitors will register, at time of entry, for a 10-minute timeslot to present their garment(s) on the 4-H stage before a pair of judges. The 4-H Stage is a new addition to the Fair Project display area, located in the back of Mendota room 8, where Pocket Pets were previously. (Pocket Pets will remain in the same room, moving to the south wall.) There will be audience seating.

Exhibitors may enter their garment in both the Clothing, Knitting & Crochet Revue and Clothing or Knitting & Crocheting Department. The garment entered in both sections will be judged separately: a) Style and garment presentation and b) garment construction. Judge comments from each section will remain separate for the garment. Clothing Revue garments up for consideration for special awards will be reviewed on the hanger by the pair of Revue judges.

All exhibitors participating in the Clothing, Knitting & Crocheting Revue must model their garments in the Style Revue Show to receive premiums. The Style Review Show will be held Sunday, July 19 at 1 p.m. on the Awards Stage in Exhibition Hall A. Watch for more information on when and where participants must be ready.
