

# Dane County Non-4-H Organizations Horse & Pony Project Educational Requirement Form 2020

- When must my education hours be submitted?
  - Education hours must be received by the **Dane County Fair** office on or before June 15th to count for that project year.
- Where must education hours be submitted?

## **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED**

Requirements for Non-4-H Organization Horse & Pony and Horseless Horse (where available) members to show at the Dane County Fair:

1. All non-4-H organization members Grade 3 or higher are **required** to attend the Dane County 4-H Horse & Pony Education Safety Orientation clinic once prior to showing at the Dane County Fair. (The 2020 clinic is April 5, 2020 from 10:00 a.m. – Noon at the Dane County Extension Office, 5201 Fen Oak Drive, Madison. - Information can be found in the Dane County 4-H Youth Development – Horse & Pony website: <https://fyi.uwex.edu/dane4hyouth/4-h-projects/horse-pony/> If there is a conflict with the Safety Orientation, please contact the Fair Office for other options to complete this requirement.
2. All non-4-H organization members are **required** to attend one (1) Dane County 4-H Horse & Pony approved hands-on clinic with their project animal
  - a. Non-4-H organization members in grade 13 are exempt from bringing their horse to a 4-H approved clinic, provided they have fulfilled this requirement for the previous three (3) years.
3. Driving (line or cart) non-4-H members wishing to show at the Dane County Fair in driving must participate with their intended project animal in one hands-on 4-H Horse & Pony sponsored driving clinic. A knowledgeable reinsman 17 years or older must ride in the cart if the driver is in grade 8 or under and the pony/horse is 40 inches or greater.
4. Participants must sign the roster for each Dane County Horse & Pony Education Committee event attended.
5. If attending a pre-approved event not sponsored by the Dane County Horse & Pony Education Committee, the participant must have the clinician sign the education card.
6. If a non-4-H organization member must cancel from a 4-H Horse & Pony sponsored clinic, he/she must contact the clinic coordinator at least 48 hours prior to the start of the clinic. He/she must have a verbal/written confirmation from the clinic coordinator. If this confirmation is not obtained, double the hours originally signed up for will be deducted from his/her educational hours.
7. All Department 6 guidelines apply with the exception that helmets are **required** at all 4-H sponsored clinics.

What can satisfy education events?

- Club/chapter education hours with or without a clinician count up to a maximum of two hours per project year and must have the signature of the project leader or club/chapter leader. This includes SAE, CDE and Hippology.
- All Dane County 4-H Horse & Pony Education Committee approved clinics
