

## Calling all Animal Exhibitors!

Dane County Farm Bureau is pleased to offer educational grants to youth exhibitors to create an informative display about your animal project again this year! These displays will help educate Dane County Fair attendees about the animals at the Fair and the story of agriculture! Plus, you can use these displays at other events, such as the Wisconsin State Fair or a community petting zoo.

### Here's how to apply for a grant:

1. Brainstorm with a friend, fellow exhibitors, or your 4-H club or FFA chapter about what you'd like Fair attendees to know after visiting the animal barns.
2. Select a key message or focus for your display. Identify two unique facts about your animal species to be used in the Dane County AgVenture Scavenger Hunt.
3. Choose how you'll communicate this key message or focus. Decide what materials you'll need, the information you'll include on your display and who will coordinate each detail.
4. Create a budget for your display.
5. Complete the application and submit it to Dane County Farm Bureau Ag Promotions Chair, Lindsey Hellenbrand via email at [lmhellenbrand@uwalumni.com](mailto:lmhellenbrand@uwalumni.com). All applications must be received on or before **Friday, June 4, 2021**.

You'll be contacted by June 18, 2021 in regard to your application. Grants will be awarded at the Dane County Fair, once your display is complete and on display throughout the duration of the Fair.

### A few rules:

- Displays must be new. Previous grant-winning projects may be included in the display but must be improved upon for consideration (i.e. new pieces added).
- Displays must be set up and available to view throughout the entire duration of the fair. If they are not, the grant will no longer be awarded.
- The display must meet the satisfaction of the Dane County Farm Bureau board and must include the educational facts shared in the application (additional facts are encouraged). Dane County Farm Bureau reserves the right to award funds to deserving clubs.
