



Clothing Revue Moves to the Fair: Thursday, July 15

The Clothing, Knitting & Crocheting Revue will be held at Fair on Thursday, July 15, 2021 from 3 p.m. – 6:30 p.m. to showcase your project to judges and Fair-goers.

Exhibitors will register, at time of entry, for a 10-minute timeslot to present their garment(s) on the 4-H stage before the judges. The 4-H Stage is a new addition to the Fair Project display area, located in the back of Mendota room 8, where Pocket Pets were previously. There will be audience seating, socially distanced.

Exhibitors may enter their garment in both the Clothing, Knitting & Crochet Revue and Clothing or Knitting & Crocheting Department. The garment entered in both sections will be judged separately: a) Style and garment presentation and b) garment construction. Judge comments from each section will remain separate for the garment. Clothing Revue garments up for consideration for special awards will be reviewed on the hanger by the Revue judges.

By moving the Clothing Revue to Thursday of the Fair, removes the need for a second presentation on Sunday. Style Revue Show will be intertwined with the presentation on Thursday only.
