- Entry process will remain the same – online through FairEntry.
  - Open NOW, Closes June 3, 2021, at 11:59pm.
- **NEW this year – payments may be processed by credit card or check (by June 9) directly to the Fair.**
  - Club leaders **do not** collect payments.
  - Entries, admission wristbands, shavings/bedding, shirts, privacy panels, etc. all processed through FairEntry.
- NEW Fair Shirts – all exhibitors, family members, Chairs/Superintendents will have the option to purchase Fair shirts through FairEntry to show your Fair spirit. The shirt will be Heather Kelly Green and an image will be added to the Youth Exhibitors page on the website soon.

# ANIMAL PROJECTS (1-11, 13)

- No changes to the schedule; refer to the Premium Book for Department details.
  - Move-in = Wednesday, July 14
  - Shows = Thursday, July 15-Sunday, July 18
  - Move-out = Sunday, July 18 (Process TBA in June)
- If County Public Health regulations change, the Fair may move to one-day shows for some species departments (move-in, show, move-out all in one-day).
- Judging will be performed in-person respecting current pandemic guidelines, and regulations. More information to come.
- Additional animal health regulations will be required for some species; refer to the Premium Book.

- Animals displayed during Fair (July 15-18)

## Move-out

- Sunday, July 18
- No overnight stays of exhibitors or guardians are permitted on Sunday night
